


Joining Your Zoom Class Session

We recommend testing Zoom before accessing your first class on Wednesday. You can do so at <https://zoom.us/test>.

Please join each Zoom session a few minutes before the scheduled class start time. This will help prevent last minute difficulties. Here's how to join:

1. Log into Canvas Courseworks, and navigate to the page for your course.
2. Click the blue link that says *Zoom Class Sessions* on the bottom-left hand hand of the screen. It will take you to a page that looks like this:

3. Find the session that corresponds to the current date and time (it should be near the top of the page) and click the *Join* button. **If it's your first time using Zoom, you will be prompted to download the application.** Please follow the instructions that are on your screen for download.
4. You will then have the opportunity to link the audio from your computer or phone; while it is generally easiest to join by computer, joining by phone can be useful if your computer does not have a built in-microphone or your internet connection is slow.
